General Information

The Glazer Family Dreamers Resource Center at California State University, Los Angeles, is proud to offer scholarships to undocumented students who demonstrate a commitment to their education and community. The scholarship reflects the University's commitment to the educational success of all undocumented students (Dreamer, AB540, AB2000, SB68, DACA, non-DACA). The scholarship awards \$500 to AB540/AB2000/SB68 students, and \$1,000 to non-AB540/AB2000/SB68 students enrolled during fall 2018 and spring 2019.

Available Scholarship Awards

- 6 scholarships awarded to AB540/AB2000/SB68 eligible students (\$500 per scholarship award)
- 3 scholarships awarded to students NOT eligible for AB540/AB2000/SB68 (\$1,000 per scholarship award)

Eligibility Requirements

Scholarship recipients must meet these requirements:

- Must be considered an undocumented student
- Must be an undergraduate student
- Must have at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA
- Must have enrolled and taken classes at Cal State LA during fall 2018
- Must be currently enrolled and taking classes at Cal State LA during spring 2019

Application Procedure

Application

- Completed application form, which should also include responses to three essay prompts

Unofficial Transcript

- Submit an unofficial copy of your transcript (from GET)

Deadline & Submission

The Dreamers Scholarship application packet should be submitted in person by **5 p.m. on Friday, April 19, 2019**. Please submit the application in person to the Dreamers Resource Center, located in the Student Affairs building, second floor room 214 (SA-214). *Late and/or incomplete applications will NOT be accepted, and no exceptions will be made.*

DEADLINE

FRIDAY, APRIL 19, 2019; BY 5 p.m.

Guidelines

- All responses should be neat and complete
- Grammar and spelling should be checked for accuracy
- Follow directions and stay within the word count maximum
- *More does not always mean better*—ensure that your responses to the essay prompts concisely answer the prompts
